In order to learn from the experiences of promoting the implementation of the ICCPR&ICESCR in countries which are advanced in human rights and refer to the practice of training civil servants' concept of human rights, the Ministry of Justice invited Canada's famous human rights scholars and experts, Professor William Black and Ms. Magda Seydegart to have thematic speeches on November 30, 2010. Mr. Scott Fraser, the representative of the Canadian Trade Office in Taipei, was also invited to have greetings prior to the speech. These speeches provided inspiration to act in accordance with international human rights standards and to improve the quality of government administration.
